The neighbors used to suffer the consequences of the plant's activities. However once the plant stopped working as such, the towers remained as the symbol of the neighborhood's pride. The proposal presents a new axis that offers to citizens the possibility of enjoying the towers. In this way, a new urban space is created.

This system of exterior spaces interconnects the nearby natural spaces with the different free urban spaces produced by the city. It is a simple structure, defined by the possibilities of free space existing as a tangible use, for the city's organization and for its landscape's comprehension.

The grand metropolitan boulevard is an actual version of what a promenade can be. It is a space for circulation where movement becomes as important as the symbolic, visual communication that expresses the high scale of the territory. It reinforces the sense of continuity between different city areas.
