The Biennial will present a wide range of well known, insightful, and charismatic keynote speakers, including Professor of Sociology, Saskia Sassen, University of Chicago, in a panel debate with the mayors on Ancona, Vilnius and Frederiksberg.

Professor of Geography, Meric S.Gertler, University of Toronto, Professor Anne Power, London School of Economics, and Professor François Ascher, Institut Francais d'Urbanisme, will highlight the current challenges of the European city from various perspectives. The Biennial is held every second year in a major European city. The first Biennial was held in Lyon in 1995. Since, the Biennial has been held in Rome, Herne, Rotterdam, Barcelona and now in the Øresund Region.
