



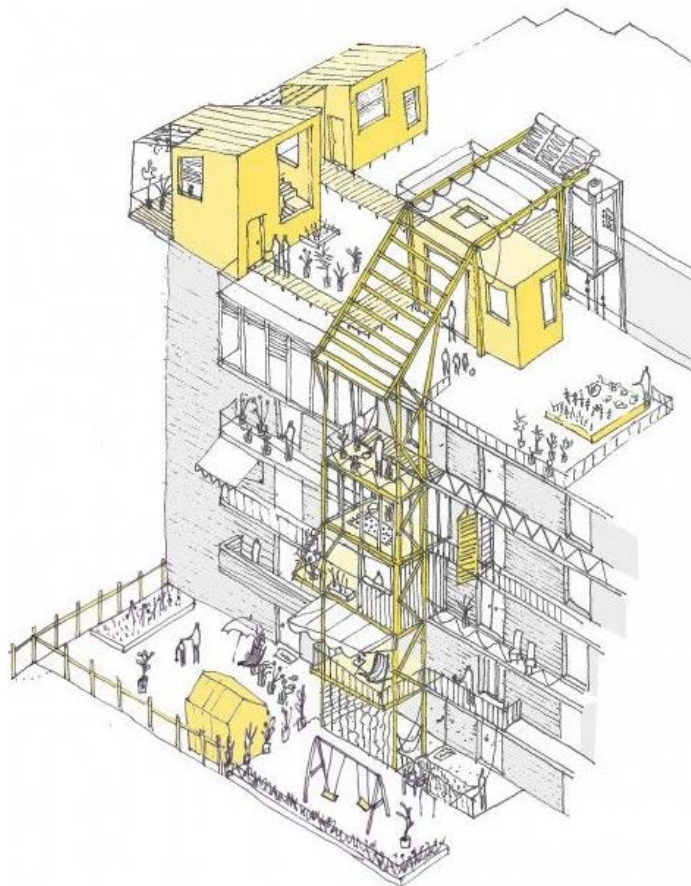

HABITATGES COL·LABORATIUS (COHOUSING)

Data d'elaboració: Juliol 2016, actualitzada març 2018

Definició d'habitatge col·laboratiu (o cohabitatge): *Es un tipo de comunidad cohesionada por su forma de entender la relación entre vida privada y vida común. Está formada por viviendas privadas y una dotación importante de servicios comunes. Está planeada y gestionada por sus residentes, según el modelo que ellos mismos deciden, lo que les permite definir el proyecto según sus necesidades específicas reales. Para conseguir un coste moderado las viviendas, aún contando normalmente con equipamiento completo, suelen reducir su superficie habitual para dedicarla a los espacios comunes.* [Font definició: <http://ecohousing.es/que-es-ecohousing/que-es-cohousing/>]
